7 ORGANIZATIONAL HACKS FOR YOUR RV

RVs may be big on fun, but oftentimes, they're small on space. These 7 must-have gadgets can make your life easier and more organized out on the road.



1 | STACKABLE CLOSET ORGANIZERS

Sometimes the only way to go in an RV is up! Stackable organizers have a small footprint but substantially increase what you can squeeze into a small space.



2 | OVER-THE-STOVE CUTTING BOARD

Counter space can be hard to come by in a rig. Make your stove do double-duty by placing a large cutting board on top of it when it isn't in use.

WHAT TO PACK WHEN RVING WITH PETS

Don't leave Fido at home when setting out on your next RV trip! RVing with pets can be a rewarding experience—as long as you pack the right things.

1 | FOOD, WATER, AND BOWLS

Pack enough food for the duration of your trip (plus a little extra) in an airtight container to keep it fresh. Don't forget your pet's favorite treats for rewards and snacks!

2 | LEASH AND COLLAR/HARNESS

Even if your pup is well trained, most RV parks have an on-leash dog policy. Ensure you have a sturdy leash and a properly fitting collar or harness for walks and outdoor activities.

3 | ID TAGS / MICROCHIP

Make sure your pet wears a collar with up-to-date identification tags containing your contact information. Be sure that the info tied to their microchip is also up-to-date.

4 | BED OR CRATE

Provide your pet with a comfortable space to rest during the journey and at your destination. If you're headed to a colder destination, be sure to pack their favorite blanket as well!

5 | AMPLE AMOUNT OF POOP BAGS

Don't be the person that leaves an unpleasant present at your neighbor's RV site. Always be sure to pack more poop bags than you think you'll use.

6 | FAVORITE TOYS FROM HOME

Bring along a few familiar toys from home to help your furry friend feel more comfortable in unfamiliar surroundings.

7 CLASSIC ROAD TRIP GAMES FOR KIDS

Half of the fun of a road trip is in the journey! Put away the screens and make memories the old fashioned way—with a classic road trip game. Parents, you might just be surprised how much fun you have playing, too.

1 | LICENSE PLATE GAME

In this classic road trip game, kids try to spot license plates from as many different states or countries as possible during their journey, often keeping track of the sightings on a scorecard or checklist.

2 | 20 QUESTIONS

Players take turns thinking of an object, animal, or person, and others have 20 questions to guess what it is, with only "yes" or "no" answers allowed.

3 | THE ALPHABET GAME

Players search for words starting with each letter of the alphabet in order, either on signs, license plates, or objects outside the car. The game starts when someone spots something that starts with the letter A!

4 | NAME THAT TUNE

Hum, sing, or play a snippet of a song, and others guess the song title or artist. It's a great way to spark a love for the oldies in your kids!

5 | LICENSE PLATE STORIES

Spot a license plate and create a short story or sentence using the letters or numbers on it as the beginning of each word. For example, if the license plate reads "ABC 123," the sentence could start with "A big cat" for "ABC" and "1, 2, 3, jump!"

6 | TRAVEL TRIVIA

Prepare a list of trivia questions related to the destinations you'll be passing through or general knowledge about road trips, and see who can answer the most correctly.


7 | WORD SNAKE

In Word Snake, players build on each other's words by naming compound words that start with the last word said, for example, "sunflower - flower pot - potluck - lucky charm." See how long you can go!
